

ACE 1: Is it possible to lose your salvation?

Approaching with Confidence towards Eternity

Hebrews 4:16: “Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.”

Examples of Salvation without Baptism: (What about the paralytic man in Luke 5, the sinful woman in Luke 7, the thief on the cross in Luke 23)

IMPORTANT VERSES ABOUT SALVATION

Matthew 19:24-26—More difficult for a camel to...than a rich man...

Mark 16:15-16—He who believes and is baptized will be saved

Acts 4:12—Salvation is found in no one else...no other name by which men are saved

Acts 8:36-39—Philip baptizes the Ethiopian Eunuch

Acts 9:17-18—Ananias baptizes Saul

Acts 16:29-33—The Jailor and his family are baptized

Romans 10:9-13—If you believe in your heart and confess, you will be saved

IMPORTANT VERSES ABOUT KEEPING YOUR SALVATION

Luke 18:9-14—The tax collector said, “God, have mercy on me, a sinner.”

Romans 8:1-4—No condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus...the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us...but (who live) according to the Spirit

1 Corinthians 15:1-2—By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word...

2 Timothy 1:8-10—Who has saved us and called us to a holy life

Hebrews 3:12-19—See to it that none of you...turns away from the living God...

Hebrews 4:1-2, 11—None of you be found to have fallen short...the message was of no value because they did not combine it with faith...no one will fall by disobedience

Hebrews 6:4-6—Impossible for those...if they fall away, to be brought back

Hebrews 6:9-12—Even though we speak like this, dear friends, we are confident of better things in your case—things that accompany salvation. ¹⁰God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them. ¹¹We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, in order to make your hope sure. ¹²We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

THE KEY TO BEING CONFIDENT IN YOUR SALVATION IS FOUND IN REPEATEDLY APPROACHING THE THRONE OF GRACE TO RECEIVE MERCY AND FIND GRACE TO HELP YOU IN YOUR TIME OF NEED.
